Call for Student Exchange Programme with the University of Primorska (Koper, Slovenia) in the frame of the Erasmus+ Programme (KA107)

1. Background

The University of Primorska (UP) is a public university in Slovenia. In the frame of the Erasmus+ programme, the UP has obtained funds for enabling student exchange (for study) with partner universities from **Bosnia and Herzegovina**, **India**, **Israel**, **Jordan**, **Montenegro and Uzbekistan** (see enclosure 1_Granted mobilities)

Erasmus+ programme is a European programme stimulating mobility between different educational institutions (http://ec.europa.eu/programmes/erasmus-plus/index en.htm).

2. Mobility period, duration and obligations

All mobilities have to be completed by 31 July 2022.

3. Duration of mobility

Candidates for Bosnia and Hercegovina, Montenegro and Uzbekistan are invited for **5 months**1) Candidates for India, Israel and Jordan are invited for **3 months**

4. Eligibility

The Student Exchange Programme is open to students from UP's partner universities from Bosnia and Herzegovina, India, Israel, Jordan, Montenegro and Uzbekistan who study in the area related to the study fields offered at Faculty of Humanities (UP FHŠ), Faculty of management (UP FM), Faculty of Mathematics, Natural Sciences and Technologies (UP FAMNIT), Faculty of Education (UP PEF), Faculty of Tourism Studies-Turistica (UP FTŠ TURISTICA) and Faculty of Health (UP FVZ):

5. Erasmus+ mobility grant

The student will receive the Erasmus+ mobility grant that includes:

- a) Subsistence costs (accommodation, local transfer and other costs) is 800,00 € per month
- b) <u>Travel costs*</u>: contribution to the travel costs from participant's place of origin to the venue of the activity and return:

6. Other conditions

Before the start of the mobility (student exchange), two documents need to be signed:

- 1) The Erasmus+ interinstitutional agreement between the host institution (UP) and the sending institution (Bosnia and Herzegovina, India, Israel, Jordan, Montenegro and Uzbekistan's partner university); and
- 2) the Learning Agreement between the host institution, the sending institution and the student; the Learning Agreement defines the activities that will be carried out by the participant during the exchange period.

7. Deadline, submission and selection process

The sending institution is responsible for nominating maximum **2** candidates for mobility by providing the name of the candidate to the host institution (UP FHŠ, UP FM, UP FAMNIT, UP PEF, UP FTŠ TURISTICA or UP FVZ).

^{*}The travel cost will be reimbursed according to the original invoices provided by the student at his/her arrival.





The selection criteria for the nomination are left entirely to the sending institution. When providing the nomination, the sending institution guarantees that all eligible students at its institution were given a fair and equal chance for participation and that the nominated student best matched for the mobility.

Deadline for nomination: February 15 (The call is open until there are available places).

The sending institution (its International Relations Office or other competent department /person) has to provide in its nomination e-mail to UP the following details before the deadline:

- Name and surname of the candidate;
- o Semester, study year and field of study
- o Include the motivation letter and transcript of records for the nominated students.

UP will then review the proposed candidates from all partner universities and do the selection of one candidate based on:

- Motivation letter,
- Transcripts of records.

Before the start of her/his mobility the selected candidate will have to supply also the following information and documents:

- o Permanent residence;
- Bank details (in Slovenia) (bank account, routing number, bank branch address), if the costs will be reimbursed to them.
