

Useful Information for Students

·····	Your coordinator or professor should officially nominate you via Mobility Online.	
May 1 st for the upcoming winter semester November 1 st for the upcoming summer semester		
Once your coordinator at your home university has nominated you via our platforr you will receive an email with a registration link for your Mobility Online applicati as well as other vital information on several topics (e.g. your faculty).		
Make sure to complete your personal data, indicate an emergency contact (this can- not be yourself!), upload a photo as well as a language certificate. In case you are a native speaker or studying in English, please upload a document mentioning this.		
Once the registration has been formally checked, you will be able to upload your application documents. As soon as the documents have been checked by the faculty, you will be informed that you can print out your letter of admission and start preparing your digital enrolment.		
The Learning Agreement is mandatory for ERA This is a <u>3 part system</u> , more information can be f Learning Agreement".		
All other students do not have to submit a Learning Agreement.		
Students will have to pay the semester fee of approx. € 350. This fee covers public transportation in the whole North Rhine - Westphalia region. Students will receive their MultiCa (earliest March/September 1 st) only after having paid the semester fee. The MultiCa is their student card and valid in our library.		
Unfortunately, TH Köln does not offer on-campus dormitories. Information on how to get accommodation in Cologne/ Gummersbach can be found on this website . Students can apply at the Kölner Studierendenwerk (KSTW), which offers student accommodation. Please apply early and be open for more than one choice to make sure you get a room, even if it is not in the location you would have preferred. If you do not get a room in student housing, there are other options such as subletting rooms in shared flats.		
Pass/fail. Exchange students get grades based on the German grading system: 1 (excellent) - 5 (not sufficient).		
In order to gain credits, all students have to actively participate in the coursework and exams (or other relevant assessments) of their chosen courses. Be prepared to do coursework and exams even if your home university would not re- quire it. TH Köln generally does not issue certificates of attendance for courses. Please ask your professors about the required coursework at the beginning of your stay.
